Ms. Edwards,

Attached (and numbered below) are four attachments that give an overview of the incident at our home on 9-9-14, wherein a DWP employee entered our property without an appointment, and despite being warned that we have dogs on the property, continued on and assaulted our dog, Ralph. Your employee purportedly acknowledged to the DWP that day that he hit our dog, and he said that he was acting in self defense.

After many back and forth's with the DWP and the City Attorney/ DWP, as the attachments show, I was recently notified that all the information on the assault that DWP will release to me is the name of the DWP employee that assaulted our dog, an employee named Jabril Durr.

1. My 8-29-14 initial email to DWP about the incident that day via the DWP web site.
2. My 9-9-14 more formal email complaint and explanation of the DWP employee attack on our dog, with photos of our home entrance.
3. A 10-23-14 email letter from Gregory Adams, essentially telling me that the DWP won't provide me with any information – other than the name of the employee that struck our dog.
4. Greg Adams/ Deputy city attorney 10-27-14 email to me, in essence telling me the only information I can get from DWP is the name of their employee that admitted to being on our property on 8-29-14 and admitted to striking our dog.

I'm writing to you as General manager, as the DWP's position on this incident seems at best unfair. I'm hoping that you will intercede before I go up the chain-of-command/ go public about the incident, and about DWP's response to it.
